

Uddaraju Ananda Raju Foundation Blood Bank was established in the year 2009 to serve the needy of Blood. It providing around 2000 units of Blood per annum to the people in and around Bhimavaram. People suffering from Thalassemia and Hemophilia are given blood units free of cost and even charges from blood sample testing are not collected from them. Required blood units are given at a lower cost than prescribed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.



Biofloc Technology from Theory to Practice

Prof. Yoram Avnimelech got an M.Sc. in Soil Science-Microbiology (1960) and Ph.D. in Soil Science-Physical Chemistry (1964) from the Hebtew University. He was the Dean of the department of Agricultural Engineering and the Chief Scientist of the Israeli Ministry of Environmental Protection.

He developed novel technologies of intensive fish and shrimp systems, based on the control of the microbial system in the pond (Bio Floc Technology), heads the AES working group on biofloc technology and wrote a book on this topic. He served as a board member AES and presently is director in WAS BOD, chairing the membership and promotion committee.

Yew-Hu Chien, Ph.D., Professor in Department of Aquaculture and Dean of Office of International Affairs, National Taiwan Ocean University (NTOU), obtained his Ph.D. in Marine Sciences and M.App.Stat. in Experimental Statistics, Louisiana State University in 1980. He has been Chairman of Department of Aquaculture, NTOU; Board of Director (BD), Secretary, and Vice President of the World Aquaculture Society (WAS); BD of Asia-Pacific Chapter of WAS; Council of the Asian Fisheries Society (AFS); Secretary of Taiwan Chapter of AFS; Coordinator of Fishery Science Program of National Science Council in Taiwan; Editor-in-Chief of Journal of Fisheries Society of Taiwan; Associate Editor of Journal of the World Aquaculture Society; Contributing editor of several aquaculture and aquatic biology related journals. His expertise encompasses the field of aquaculture management, particularly on water and sediment management, feed and nutrition, and aquaculture resource planning. Both government and private agencies have commissioned him as consultant on assessment and development of aquaculture industry and aquaculture training programs in more than 30 countries.
